Architectural Review forms are available at the clubhouse. You can print a form from our website and submit it online as well. When painting, exact colors (with color number) that is to be used for the house, trim and/or driveway must be listed on the form along with the current roof color of the home

The committee meets each third Thursday of the month if required. Somerset is a beautiful community. Thank you to all the residents we keep it that way.

## Out and About In Our Community

Friends and Neighbors,  
Here it is May 1, 2022. One third of this calendar year is gone and June 1st is 30 days away.

Prayerfully all of you are working feverishly on your hurricane preparation as you were reminded last month. You still have time. The Orange County Sheriff, the HOA's and our neighbors identified several issues that must be rectified. The streets and citizens of Williamsburg are experiencing challenges that are endangering our first responders and homeowners. The issues identified by the Orange County Sheriff are as follows:

- Menacing vehicular recklessness of up to several vehicles laying donuts during the wee hours throughout Williamsburg. OCS requests you call them immediately on 911. DO NOT ENGAGE these individuals!
- Too many vehicles parked inappropriately. Cars parked on opposite sides of some streets are not leaving enough room for larger emergency vehicles, Orange County Waste Management vehicles and delivery vehicles to pass safely. Homeowners are requested to park all their vehicles in their driveway or in such a manner as to NOT impede aforementioned vehicles. Vehicles may be receiving tickets or possibly towed. Those decisions will be made by the first responders on duty.
- All homeowners are reminded to always use sidewalks. Walking in the street is against county ordinances in all cases, if there is a sidewalk available. If there is a problem with a section of sidewalk that may affect your health, report it to the county for repair. First responders may start ticketing people for non compliance. Where there is no sidewalk available and you must walk on the street, please walk facing traffic. Walking facing traffic will save your life. Williamsburg doesn't want any citizen in the hospital or cemetery. These requests are within the law and to protect you, our neighbor and friend. The ordinances are for your safety and the safety of every one of your neighbors.

Please adjust your personal situation accordingly and help each other. Remember, not everyone reads this newsletter, so reach out to your neighbors, make a new friend and help them. We are all in this life together and we all share this piece of paradise.

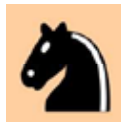

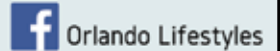

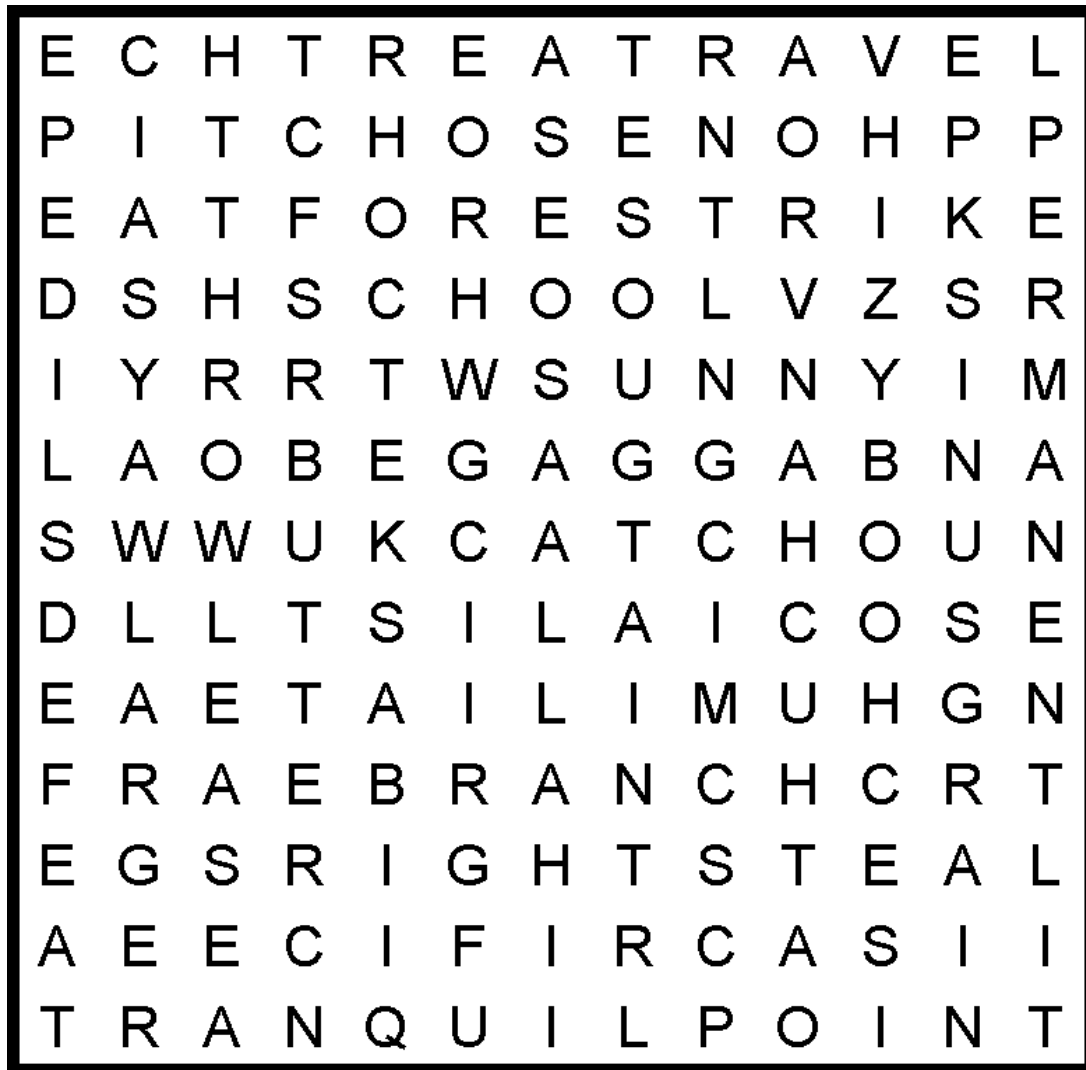

## MEMORIAL DAY

Memorial Day began as a memorial for Civil War veterans. It has become both, a National Decoration Day of family graves, and the holiday that opens the summer season. It is celebrated with backyard barbecues, outdoor picnics, and parades.

Waterloo, New York was recognized by President Lyndon Johnson and both houses of Congress, as the birthplace of Memorial Day because the town decorated the graves of Civil War veterans as early as May 5, 1866. The claim is contested by Boalsburg, Pennsylvania, which claims to have begun the practice of decorating soldier's graves two years

earlier than Waterloo. Another source claims that two years after the Civil War, it was southern women in Columbus, Mississippi who decorated the graves of both Confederate and Union men. Nevertheless, sources agree that it was General John A. Logan of the Grand Army of the Republic who designated May 30, 1868, " as a day for strewing with flowers or otherwise decorating the graves of comrades who died in defense of their country, and whose bodies now lie in almost every city, village, or hamlet churchyard in the land...It is the purpose of the commander-in-chief to inaugurate this observance with the hope that it will be kept from year to year while a survivor of the war remains to honor the memory of the departed."

No survivor of that war remains, but the memories of it grow longer. As do our memories of the parades with floats; civic organizations and drum majorettes twirling their batons; lines and lines of young veterans from The Gulf War and shorter lines of older men who saw service in the Second World War. As long as there are wars, there will be veterans and casualties. We will still decorate the graves of those men

whose bodies came home and remember those who don't.

The custom of placing flowers upon graves is an old one, and exists in many countries. The Greeks had rites called zoai, which were performed over each new grave. If the flowers took root and blossomed on the graves, it meant the souls were sending back the message that they had found happiness. The Roman festival, called Parentalia, or Day of the Fathers, lasted for eight days in February—violets and roses were the special flowers. Whatever the flower, wherever the grave, this placing of flowers upon graves has always seemed the natural thing to do.

Today, most states officially recognize the May Memorial Day as a legal holiday, but it is not celebrated on May 30th in every state. Over time the holiday has expanded to encompass our other national wars. Although Veteran's Day is celebrated as well, Memorial Day has become the most important day of recognition of our armed forces.
