Holiday season is approaching and November traditionally is a busy season for us here on the ARC. Many homeowners are interested in sprucing up their properties for the approaching holidays. This is also a nice time of year to work outdoors due to the heat subsiding a bit. Please remember that planting trees also require an ARC form to be submitted

The ARC has had many requests for new roofs in the last few months. When you receive your approval letter you will see that it is your responsibility to have your roofing contractor tarp around your home to catch all the flying nails and debris. The contractor must also clean up any nails that are not caught by the tarp and made their way onto your lawn. We have been receiving numerous complaints from our landscaping company of repeated flat tires after roof install. Please remember to remind your roofer of the cleanup rule.

Architectural Review forms are available at the clubhouse as well as our website. When painting, please be sure to come to the office and look at the approved color book, Exact colors (with color number) that is to be used for the house, trim and/or driveway. It must be listed on the form along with the current roof color of the home.

Please remember that if any changes are being made to the outside of your home ARC approval is needed prior to beginning your project

The committee meets each third Thursday of the month if required. ARC sends you many warm wishes for a Happy Thanksgiving.


