WATER

Run your car without water in the radiator, and it will come to a steaming halt. Yet people who wouldn't dream of letting their cars run dry often walk around without enough water in their own radiators. And because every cell in the body requires fluids to dissolve and transport vitamins, minerals, sugar and other chemicals, not drinking enough water can leave you feeling like a run-down Ford.

The average person loses about 2 percent of his body weight in urine, perspiration, and other body fluids every day. To replace these fluids, doctors advise drinking at least eight glasses of water, milk or juice a day. More if you're a large person, over age 55, sick with a cold, or simply active.

To make sure you drink enough, the brain has special sensors in a part of the brain called the thalamus, which monitor blood levels of sodium. When concentrations of sodium rise, it means that water levels are low. The brain then sends a signal in the form of thirst that says it's time to head to the water cooler.

FATIGUE

We think of fatigue as being caused by not getting enough sleep or working too hard. But in many cases, the problem is even more basic: not getting enough water.

Here's what happens. When you don't drink enough, cells throughout your body start getting a little dry. To quench their thirst, they draw water from the most convenient place - the blood-stream. This leaves the blood thick, sludgy, and harder to pump. The extra work involved in pumping the blood can cause energy levels to decline.

HEART ATTACK: KNOW THE SIGNS

You're a little nauseated and lightheaded. Your back hurts. What do you think? You're coming down with something, what you ate for breakfast didn't settle, you carried too much laundry up the stairs? They are all plausible explanations. Here's another: you're having a heart attack.

In an American Heart Association survey, only about half of women were aware of certain warning signs; of others, even less. A heart attack occurs when a blockage stops blood flow (and oxygen) to your heart. Some cases are what you picture: intense chest pain, difficulty breathing. But most heart attacks start much less dramatically, with mild pain or discomfort.

Some Signs:

Chest Pain - It's uncomfortable pressure, squeezing fullness, or pain in the center of your chest that lasts more than a few minutes or goes away and comes back. If you have chest pain, especially with another of these symptoms, don't wait more than five minutes to call 911.

Upper Body Discomfort - It can be in one or both arms, your back, neck, jaw or stomach.

Shortness of Breath - This can be with or without chest pain.

Other Signs - Breaking out in a cold sweat, nausea, or light-headedness.

First Aid Update - Heart attack victims may go into cardiac arrest and require cardio-pulmonary resuscitation. Given immediately, CPR can double or triple a person's chance of survival.


