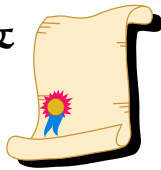

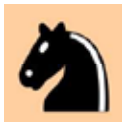



HOT-AIR HAND DRYERS

Microbiology scientists have found that the outlet nozzles of some hot-air hand dryers in public restrooms are contaminated by bacteria, because some people don't wash their hands properly before drying them.

Unfortunately, the heat produced by hot-air hand dryers is the perfect temperature to encourage bacterial growth. Organisms such as salmonella and E. coli can be blown onto people's hands, bodies and clothes by the blasting air stream from hot-air dryers.

The importance of washing your hands is obvious, but the benefits may be undone if you don't dry them properly, because wet hands are better at passing on germs than dry ones, say microbiology scientists. The safest way to dry your hands in public restrooms is to use disposable paper towels. They dry your hands quicker than electric hot-air dryers, and they are a lot more hygienic. Paper towels leave hands 96 per cent dry after just ten seconds. After 15 seconds, the hands are 99 per cent dry. An electric air drier takes at least 45 seconds, and may expose you to bacteria that can be harmful to your health.

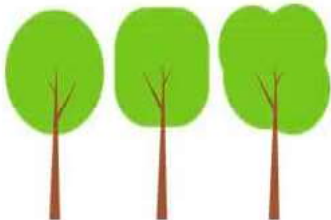
