The Williamsburg Homeowners Association Board of Directors hopes everyone had an enjoyable holiday season. Here's an update:

The median in front of Publix on Central Florida Parkway (CFP) between Orangewood and Gateway had gone unmown for quite some time, was an eyesore, and a source of complaints throughout the community. On January 17th I called and spoke to an agent at OC 311 and was told that the County will be maintaining the median on a regular basis once they have found a vendor to do the work. I await their response as to when work commences.

On a monthly basis I have been collecting and disposing of trash and debris along Gateway, Orangewood, CFP, and the Orange County and FDOT areas along the 528. It needs to be done at least once a month and a clean sweep of those areas takes about 4-6 hours depending on how much there is to collect. The various landscape vendors do collect some of it prior to mowing, but in between mowings, drivers in our area continue to litter our roadsides with fast food wrappers, water bottles, beer cans and other miscellaneous items. At least once a week I also collect various solicitation signs at our major intersections. One afternoon alone, I collected a total of 40 signs at the intersections of Orangewood and CFP, Gateway and CFP, and Orangewood and Gateway. While I'm happy to serve, I could use some help. Feel free to reach me at williamsburghoa.orlando@gmail.com if you'd like to help.

WHOA Secretary and OC Liaison Donna Finklestein reported that she's been in communication with OC about increasing pedestrian safety with proposed LED lighting upgrades and additional lighting at crosswalks and intersections along Universal Blvd, I-Drive, and Convention Way. She is also questioning Williamsburg traffic impacts from new short term rentals on I-Drive and the proposed 262 acre Horizon West mixed use development just south of Williamsburg at Daryl Carter Parkway and I-Drive. Donna is also working on setting up another OC Town Hall Meeting. We'll be sure to keep you posted as things develop further.

Our next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, February 13, 2024 at 7:00 pm at the Lime Tree Clubhouse, 5303 Gateway Ave. All Williamsburg homeowners are welcome to attend. As always, we are grateful for your continued support and thanks for reading.


